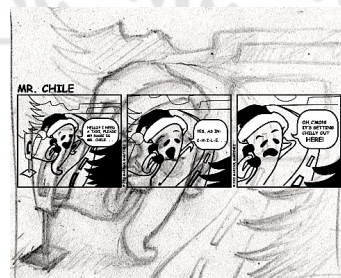
Comic Book Workshop

The workshop gives students a new approach to writing applicable to academic standards. Instruction in writing provide students with visual storytelling skills.

Comic Strip Printshop

Students will generate various illustrations on comic strip panels through the use of this art form's traditional canvas: newsprint. A collaboration with their community to *publicize* their witty comic strip in a local newspaper may be available.

Web Comics Lab

From sketch to digital form, students will go viral with their *digitized* comic book when trained to trace their sketches in Adobe Illustrator. Our lab provides online-publishing with online-sharing, as well as future sharing via flash drive.

Motion Comics Filmstrip

Students will enhance their visual storytelling skills when trained to add voice-overs, sound effects, and music to their comic book illustrations. The digital classroom transforms students' scanned drawings into motion strips.
